## 1 CONDITIONS FOR REGISTRATION AND CASE SUBMISSION

1.1 Enrollment is only valid if this Case Submission Form is completed and duly signed by each Participant and sent in together with the Case Documentation, consisting of digital images including legends, a brief patient history and a short Curriculum Vitae (CV) of each Participant, as described hereafter in the Case Documentation Requirements.

1.2 Each Participant individually represents and warrants that only Straumann® implants, abutments, bars and crowns have been used.

1.3 The Participant(s) individually represent and warrant to be the exclusive author(s) and exclusive owner(s) of all rights related to the Case Documentation submitted and that no manipulation other than cropping, rotating and/or adjustments of contrast and brightness have been performed on the digital images presented with the Case Documentation, and that all registered Participants were actively involved in the treatment.

1.4 Each Participant individually represents and warrants that all information given in connection with the Case Documentation is true and valid.

1.5 Each Participant individually represents and warrants that he or she has obtained a legally valid waiver and consent from the patient to use the images in connection with this case contest.

1.6 All Case Documentation will be subject to Straumann USA, LLC Legal and Regulatory review and will only be accepted for use after final approval.

## 2 CASE DOCUMENTATION CHECKLIST

2.1 The Case Documentation may either be provided on a CD-ROM or via email. Photographs are to be converted into a digital format. Digital images must be submitted in TIF or JPEG format and should have print quality (min. 300 dpi resolution).

2.2 An abstract of patient initial situation (anonymous; limited to dental history), chief complaint, diagnosis with explanation for why the Straumann Pro Arch solution was chosen, treatment protocol and results at furthest follow up time point in a common digital text format must be included on the CD-ROM. The maximum length of such abstract should not exceed 1500 words. **The text must be in English.**

2.3 Abstract should include the following information

- Description of the patient: age, sex, (non)smoker, any systematic diseases, patient history. Make sure that the patient's data is anonymous
- Description of the initial situation
- Description of planning and performance of the surgical operation and dental lab procedure
- Precise details of the Straumann products employed (e.g. Straumann® Bone Level Ø3.3 mm, NC, SLActive® Roxolid™ with Loxim®)
- Clinical rationale for choosing Straumann Pro Arch as the treatment solution
- Clinical result immediately after the treatment
- Clinical results after placement of the final prosthesis
- Treatment outcome from the patients' point of view including his or her benefit having Straumann Pro Arch
- Testimonial from treating clinicians about Straumann Pro Arch as a practice differentiator

2.4 The number of digital images filed must not be fewer than 2 and not more than 18. Digital images should include at least one pre-operative image and one post-operative displaying the entire treatment area. All digital images must be numbered consecutively. A concise legend (explanatory text) has to be provided with each digital image. The maximum length of such legend should not exceed 200 words. Legends must be in English and need to be numbered according to the related digital images. If one or several follow-up image(s) are provided, treatment timelines from the time of surgery to the time of follow-up image(s) must be given.

## 2.5 CASE DOCUMENTATION

### 2.5.1 Initial clinical situation – Pictures:

- Overview photograph showing teeth and gingiva
- Close-up view of the future implant site and adjacent teeth including gingiva
- Peri-apical x-ray before treatment (including an OPT, if available)

### 2.5.2 Treatment steps – Pictures:

- Implant selection
- Insertion of implant with transfer piece
- Removal of transfer piece from implant
- Insertion of SRA Abutments
- Immediate provisional step-by-step
- Provisionalization of site

### 2.5.3 Treatment outcome – Pictures:

- Overview photograph showing teeth and gingiva after placement of the definitive implant suprastructure
- Close-up view of the implant site and gingiva after placement of the definitive implant suprastructure
- Post-treatment peri-apical x-ray after implant suprastructure integration
- Lateral perspective showing the emergence profile of the implant suprastructure

### 2.5.4 Technical recommendations for case documentation:

- Photographs must be presented in a digital format (CD-ROM).
- Digital images should be defined in TIF or JPEG format and should be print quality (min. 300 dpi resolution)
- The digital images should exhibit:
  - Good and consistent illumination/light conditions
  - Consistent camera angles
  - Good sight at treatment area
  - Adjacent teeth and gingiva
- Images **should not** exhibit:
  - Retractors, fingers, dental mirrors, etc.
  - Too much blood, plaque and / or inflammation (i.e., “non-clean” sites)

## 3 REWARDS

The Case Documentations submitted to Straumann USA, LLC (“Straumann”) by Participant(s) will be reformatted in the design template. All Case Documentations will be subject to Straumann USA, LLC Legal and Regulatory review:

- Will be formally designed in a template and provided to Participants for printing purposes

- Will be featured in Straumann eNews

4.2 Straumann will evaluate all Case Documentations which meet the requirements outlined in this Case Submission Form and communicate the Selected Cases to the Participants. The decision of Straumann is final and excludes recourse to the law. Each Participant, therefore, herewith irrevocably declares to refrain from taking all and any legal actions against Straumann USA, LLC including its parent company and all its subsidiaries and affiliates.

4.3 The Case Documentations submitted will not be returned to the Participants.

4.4 This Case Submission Form is governed by US law. The exclusive place of jurisdiction is the ordinary courts of Delaware.

## 5 ASSIGNMENT OF RIGHTS
